Miria opened the meeting with Indigenous Land Acknowledgement (6:45)

Tanya shared an opening prayer

Principal/Vice-Principal's Report (7:00) PM)

- We have two new staff
- Grade 5 FI does not have a French teacher. No teacher has applied to the position.
 Teacher shortage is a board wide issue
 - O Supply teachers have been covering the class
 - Now we have secured a LTO teacher but she is not able to teach the french part of the program
 - O Hoping after reorganization we will be able to secure a French speaking teacher
- Mr. Moscattini is on a leave currently. Mr. M. Ramdin will be replacing him until he returns.
- Staff and students engaged in spirit week. There are pictures in the newsletter
- Progress reports will be going home November 10, 2020
 - Remote students will get electronic copy
 - Parent teacher interviews will happen if requested by either teacher or parent. It will be by phone.
 - o Forms had been sent home last week.
 - Nov 9-13-Teachers will conduct these calls on breaks and lunches
- Reorganization
 - O Data has been collected, hoping to have information by end of week
 - Changes are likely to take place, Teachers as well as students will be reorganized
 - This will be the last one for the year.
 - 85 students have opted to remain remote; 313 students will be in the hybrid model.

- O More kids are going to be back in the school.
- O There will be no in school learning November 13, 2020
- O School hopes to inform parents will by November 12, 2020
- November 11 2020 Remembrance day
 - School is working on doing a virtual presentation and moment of silence
 - Ms. V has reached out to the local region to see if they are going to distribute poppies to school. Open to donations by doing on cash online
 - O Children can wear their Boy Scouts and Girl guide uniforms to show support
- November 16- anti bullying week- activities will focus on anti bullying strategies
 - O This will be done virtually, so kids can stream it
- Sunday of advent November 29, 2020
 - Due to COVID restrictions, unable to have regular school masses
 - Father Joel will invite school to attend St Anne's streaming of daily mass
 - o Grad masses will also be held this way
- Register for first communion will be open for May 2021, No dates yet for confirmation
- Confirmation dates for 2019 will happen in December. Specific details will come from parish
- Sharelife
 - Last year school raised over \$1700
 - O We are hopeful that we can raise more this year

 - Money had been found from last year
 - O Dawn reached out for the 2018-2019 to see if funds are there. Ms. V has not found outstanding money from 2018-2019
